In April 2013, the City of Bismarck, City of Lincoln, and South Central Regional Water District are switching their current disinfection chemical from Chlorine to Chloramines for Drinking Water.

That means you must switch your tank and pond filters, tablets or drops to neutralize chloramines.

It's a simple, but necessary switch to protect your aquatic pet.

Just ask your store for the right product.

Chloramines are SAFE to drink for people, dogs, cats and all other NON-aquatic animals. By converting to chloramines, the City of Bismarck, City of Lincoln, and South Central Regional Water District will comply with more stringent U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) standards.
