1/13/2022 - Minutes

Call To Order

Commissioner Splonskowski called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM.

1. Roll Call

Advisory Board members present were Myra Kosse, Barb Plum, Tait Sundstrom, and Commissioner Mark Splonskowski. Others present included Janelle Combs, Whitnie Olsen, and Jason Tomanek as representatives of the City of Bismarck.

2. Public Comment

3. Approval Of Meeting Minutes

Barb Plum made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 8, 2021 meeting as presented. Vice-Chair Sundstrom seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved with board members in attendance voting in favor of the motion.

4. Goals For 2022

Vice-Chair Sundstrom made a motion to approve the goals as stated. Barb Plum seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved with board members in attendance voting in favor of the motion.
