ITEM: New Class C2 Hotel or Motel Liquor License for Expressway Suites.

REQUEST:

Consider the Introduction of and Call for a Public Hearing on a New Class I1 Restaurant Liquor License for Expressway Suites.

Please place this item on the July 9, 2019 City Commission meeting agenda.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Expressway Suites is requesting the Class C2 Hotel or Motel Liquor License at 180 East Bismarck Expressway. Liquor licenses are renewed annually and expire each year on July 31. The City of Bismarck Administration Department and the Police Department work collectively to administer the annual alcohol license renewals.

Class C-2. To a hotel or motel that provides at least forty-five rooms for transient guests, to provide on-sale or complementary alcoholic beverages to registered customers and their guests in their rooms or in a common room designated for that purpose. The value of the alcoholic beverages sold to shall not exceed the value of the alcoholic beverages given to or otherwise provided to registered customers and their guests. Any alcoholic beverage sold or provided under this license shall not be mixed or dispensed in the direct view of a minor.
