ITEM: Request to accept funding for Community-based Hypertension Pilot Event

REQUEST

Bismarck-Burleigh Public Health is requesting permission to accept grant funding from the ND Department of Health for a Community-based Hypertension Pilot Event.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Bismarck-Burleigh Public Health (BBPH) is requesting permission to accept grant funding from the ND Department of Human Services for a Community-based Hypertension Screening Event. Local public health departments interested in participating will be awarded \$5,000 to host a blood pressure screening event using a community-based approach.

If approved, BBPH would use the funding to host a screening event on Saturday, August 10, 2019 at the BisMarket for Kids Day at Kiwanis Park in Bismarck, a community event reaching multiple demographics. There will be no new FTE's and there is no match requirement for this funding.
