REQUEST

Reject all bids for the traffic signal video detection systems.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Public Works Service Operations Department received bids at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, July 8, 2019 for traffic signal video detection systems. Two bids were received and the bid tabulation is attached. The proposal from MoboTrex, bid an Iteris Video Detection System which does not meet the Detailed Specifications in the bid document. Also, the Traffic Control Corporation proposal did not meet General Specification No. 4 because the bid bond was not attached to the outside of the bid envelope. I recommend that both the Traffic Control Corporation and MoboTrex bids be rejected.

Reject all bids submitted for the Traffic Signal Video Detection Systems.
