**ITEM:** Request to allow residential solid waste collection be collected by a commercial waste hauler at The Grove

### **REQUEST**

Request Commission approval to allow residential solid waste collection to be provided by a commercial waste hauler at The Grove.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The property owners of The Grove and Renaissance Lofts, 506 N 2nd Street and 202 E Ave A respectively, are requesting permission to use commercial waste haulers to pick up garbage at their multi-family project. Due to space limitations for dumpsters outside of the structures, the developer and architect have requested permission to allow commercial waste haulers to collect their trash. At the Renaissance Lofts, they have designed an indoor dumpster location for residents. Since the City won't enter inside of the private property to retrieve the dumpsters due to liability concerns, using a commercial waste hauler to provide this service solves the issue. The location at The Grove is restricted due to required parking stalls for residents on the site, leaving a difficult retrieval route for the City garbage trucks. This tends to make collection difficult and potentially causing damage to private property potentially leading to insurance claims against the City.

### **RECOMMENDED CITY COMMISSION ACTION**

Allow for commercial waste haulers to collect, convey and dispose of residential solid waste at the multi-family project at 506 N 2nd Street and 202 E Ave A.
