

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS

March 3, 2020

On 3/3/20 at 12 p.m., the Board of City Commissioners met in the Tom Baker Room located at 221 N. 5th St. in Bismarck, N.D. This special meeting was called to discuss the decision to not approve Street Improvement No. 531 and Street Improvement No. 533 (SI 531 & SI 533) after the projects were voted against at the February 25, 2020 City Commission Meeting.

The board was requested to provide city staff with direction on the next steps and to address the consequences of not approving the resolution of necessity for SI 531 & SI 533.

Commissioner Guy moved to re-approve the creation of SI 531 and SI 533. This included the engineer's report. She also directed staff to re-draft the resolution of necessity and to restart the process on both units. Commissioner Oban seconded the motion. Upon a roll call vote, all voted aye.

Due to the re-approval of these items, the Engineering Department will be required to provide a report and republish a resolution of necessity in the newspaper, as required through North Dakota Century Code 40-22-15. This will give property owners 30-days to provide written protest for the items.

Letters will be sent to the property owners notifying them of the changes made to the Commissions' motion and will include a public hearing date of April 14, 2020.

The Commission also addressed the need for additional discussion regarding special assessments at the March 10, 2020 City Commission Meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 p.m.
