

Opioid Crises State Targeted Response (STR) Grant

- Treatment Recovery 80% / Prevention 20%
- Collaborative effort - BBPH & Heartview
- Prevention Objective: Increase availability & utilization of naloxone (Narcan) as an evidence-based opioid overdose prevention practice.
- Original end of grant cycle was April 30th
- No-cost contract extension through June 30th
- Waiting for new RFP's to re-apply for funding

Prevention Outcomes for STR Grant

Narcan Training completed since March meeting:

- Wilton Public School All-Staff Training (34)
- BJA Steering Committee (15)

TOTAL TRAINED SINCE OCT. 2017 = 347

Long-term Emergency Sheltering Committee

- Assigned subcommittees as follows:

<u>SUBCOMMITTEE</u>	<u>CHAIR</u>	<u>PURPOSE/MISSION</u>
Funding/Finance	Melanie Heitkamp	Build emergency shelter budget based on prior work completed by MVCHP. Identify possible funding sources.
Shelter Location	Nancy Guy & Randy Ziegler	Identify possible shelter locations for the community.
Agency Search	Kathleen Jones	Search for a lead agency to take over emergency sheltering July 1, 2018.
Shelter Best Practices	Lorraine Davis	Research and present information regarding emergency shelter models and best practices.
Faith Community	Sister Kathleen Atkinson	Research faith-based community involvement for an emergency shelter solution.

Long-term Emergency Sheltering Committee

- Steering Committee members met weekly (February – May 2018) to research and troubleshoot efforts for a long-term emergency shelter solution

Community Stakeholders Meeting

 - Committee chairs will share subcommittee work completed
 - United Way will provide update on long-term efforts of Sunrise Shelter
 - Stakeholders will learn about the next steps in developing a long-term (10-year) plan to address homelessness
- This stakeholders meeting concludes the work of the Long-term Emergency Shelter Steering Committee
- Begins the next chapter in moving toward a long-term plan to end homelessness in the Bismarck-Mandan-Burleigh-Morton area

Law Enforcement Medical Clearance

North Dakota Correctional Facility Standards

- “Before a facility may hold a person for detoxification, a licensed medical provider must provide medical clearance”
- Workflow: Emergency Department staff give discharge summary papers to law enforcement officer; officer give discharge summary to Burleigh County Detention Center staff
 - No additional forms required
- Stakeholders: Bismarck and Mandan PDs, Burleigh and Morton County Sheriff's Departments, Sanford Health and CHI St. Alexius

Intoxication Assessment & Decision Tree

- Discussed current process used by law enforcement when encountering an individual under the influence
- Discussed benefits of using a validated tool and decision tree
 - Increase efficient use of applicable resources
 - Minimize stakeholder liability
- Subcommittee will review assessment tools, decision tree models
 - NDDHS identify funding source to implement education/training program
 - NDDoC inquire about use of NDDoC mobile training units to efficiently disperse training

Intoxication/Withdrawal Management

- Subcommittee met 5/31/2018
- Still looking at bringing in CIT training, waiting on federal funding
- Subcommittee members will design a draft social detox facility plan
- Draft plan will be reviewed at next subcommittee meeting
