**CURB**

**Curb Pickup**—placing the container at the end of the driveway 3 feet away from any obstacles and back from the street is very helpful during sweeping and plowing.

This year, garbage and recycling collection will occur on Martin Luther King Day, Presidents' Day, and Veteran's Day.

### WASTE COLLECTION



Residential (No Charge) Recycling Drop Site is located at the Bismarck Landfill during Landfill hours of operation.



### Recycling Tidbit

Since 2014, the City collected 48.7 million pounds of recyclables. Your recycling efforts have conserved approximately 67,244 cubic yards of landfill airspace. That's enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs of 86,355 people!
