REGARDING: Traffic Data Collection Pilot Project for Bismarck

The 2021-2022 UPWP has been amended for the addition of a Signalized Intersections Traffic Data Collection Pilot Project for City of Bismarck in 2022. The pilot project will be completed in coordination with Advanced Traffic Analysis Center (ATAC) and City of Bismarck Engineering Department. The scope of work will include 6 intersections and will allow ATAC to connect these intersections to the existing Traffic Analysis Tool Website. Traffic data will be collected using existing counting equipment. ATAC will provide the needed personnel, dedicated computer, software, and management of the project. Local match is being provided by the City of Bismarck.

On May 17, 2022 the Bismarck-Mandan Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Policy Board approved the funding addition according to the attached task breakout.
