CDBG 2022 Annual Action Plan

The City of Bismarck invites the public to comment the 2022 Annual Action Plan. The 2022 Annual Action Plans outlines proposed activities to utilize the 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to address those housing and community development needs in accordance with the City's 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.

The 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan examines the housing and community development needs and identifies the overall priority needs in the city. The 2022 Annual Action Plan outlines proposed activities to utilize the 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding estimated to be \$384,881 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City of Bismarck's 2021 program year began on June 1, 2022, and ends on May 31, 2023. CDBG funds may be spent on activities related to housing, neighborhood improvements, public services, economic development, and public facilities.

Written 30-Day Comment Period: The written comment period for the 2022 Annual Action Plan runs from August 20 through September 19, 2022.
