

Applications Sought for Renaissance Zone Authority/Downtown Design Review Position

The Bismarck City Commission is seeking a candidate to serve on the Bismarck Renaissance Zone Authority/Downtown Design Review Committee. The volunteer committee has one open position, which is a term set to expire in December 2024. The term is expected to start in June 2023. Anyone residing in the City of Bismarck is eligible for this position.

The Renaissance Zone Authority is a seven-member advisory board that makes recommendations for prospective Renaissance Zone projects. The Renaissance Zone Authority also provides guidance on Downtown Design Review and other activities impacting the core of the community. The Bismarck Renaissance Zone program is currently inactive, but reauthorization from the State Department of Commerce is being pursued.

The Renaissance Zone Authority meets the second Thursday of every month at 4:00 p.m. in the City-County Building, 221 N 5th Street, Bismarck.
