### **WHAT:**

We love LEGO. You love LEGO. Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library is excited to offer a Winter LEGO Make and Take program again this year. Join us on December 1st for a fun winter-themed LEGO ornament-making event. There will be five builds to choose from: a penguin, a Christmas tree, a micro-train, a reindeer, and a snowman. The Library is providing all LEGO bricks and instructions at this free event - one ornament per person. The Library is happy to provide supplies for the first 500 people to make their own LEGO ornament to take home with them. This event is open to all ages. An adult must accompany children under age 10. All LEGO events at the Library come with a recommendation of participation by children aged five and up. This is due to the size of the pieces, which could pose a choking hazard to young children. Parents may bring younger children at their discretion, but if children are participating, they need to be old enough to build their own ornaments, and caregivers are to help children with their ornament building. Library staff will be on hand to assist but will not be leading the building process.
