**WHAT:** Kerry Grombacher is riding into Bismarck for a special afternoon of contemporary western music at Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library where he will present “Songs & Stories of the American West.” His work draws vivid portraits and tells fascinating stories that are set in the Western landscape.

“It’s a real treat to bring my western music to Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library,” songwriter Kerry Grombacher said recently, “I haven’t performed in North Dakota since my “Highway 281 Troubadour Tour” in 2010, and I am looking forward to returning to the Peace Garden State.”

Kerry Grombacher plays guitar and mandolin, and he writes contemporary western songs. His songs have been featured on the ABC-TV adventure travel show, “Born to Explore,” and on the Putumayo World Records CD “Cowboy Playground,” which was released in over 60 countries. He has released five albums of original songs, and his songs have been recorded by a list of artists that includes Jim Jones, Belinda Gail, The Texas Trailhands, Gary Prescott, and Trails & Rails.
