Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library Library Display Policy

The Library Director delegates responsibilities for displays, signs, posters, and any other printed material on display to designated staff who are solely responsible for selection, design, and arrangement. No other person, group, or organization has authority or permission to erect or maintain any display, sign, poster, or any other printed material, except for items carried by or on an individual person, in the Library building or on Library grounds. All common areas of the Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library, excluding properly scheduled meeting rooms, are not public forum for First Amendment purposes. Responsibility for displays initiated by the Library or cosponsored by the Library and other organizations, whether in the Library building or on Library grounds, is assigned to the Library Director, under authority of the Library Board of Trustees.
